We will be sharing the Envision Simi Valley project work done to date including the project goals, potential opportunities and constraints, and draft recommendations proposed for the Los Angeles Avenue and Tapo Street study areas.

Project Background

The City of Simi Valley (City) has recently acquired state grants from two California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) grant programs to develop a community vision for the Los Angeles Avenue Corridor and the historic Tapo Street Area (see map on reverse side). This vision will identify how the Los Angeles Avenue Corridor could become a Downtown area for shopping, entertainment, and mixed use residential development. It would also establish a neighborhood identity for the Tapo Street Area, with increased walkability and diverse commercial and residential opportunities. The ultimate goal is for the City to establish zoning and policy to encourage housing construction, attract new businesses, and increase the quality of life in Simi Valley.

Community Visions

Los Angeles Avenue Corridor Area

The Los Angeles Avenue
Corridor will become Simi
Valley's downtown and
will be established as a
focal point of activity that
integrates commercial,
entertainment, and
residential uses in a
mixed-use, multi-modal
environment. The several
existing shopping centers
will be enhanced to
include an engaging mix
of uses with improved
connectivity.

Tapo Street Area

The historic Tapo Street
Area will be enhanced to
create an authentic and
connected neighborhood
identity within a
pedestrian-oriented
transit village environment
that promotes diversity of
commercial and higherdensity residential uses.


Los Angeles Avenue Corridor and Tapo Street Area


